Bail in Adult Crew People Smuggling Prosecutions Instruction Number: 5

Last Updated: June 2015

General

1. This Practice Group Instruction ('PGI') supersedes Director's Litigation Instruction No. 1, issued 27 June 2012.

Bail

- 2. The following policy applies in relation to bail for adult crew people smuggling prosecutions:
 - a) Each application for bail is to be considered on its own merits, on a case by case basis;
 - b) Prosecutors are to consider all relevant bail considerations including the following:
 - applicable statutory bail considerations in the prosecuting jurisdiction; and
 - the strength of the prosecution evidence against the defendant including the role played by the defendant in the offence (that is, captain or crew); and
 - if bail is granted, the likelihood of the defendant reappearing before the court.
 - c) If bail is granted, consideration should be given to any necessary conditions of bail.
- 3. This policy will be reviewed as circumstances deem it necessary.
